The Thanksgiving Food Basket can be a cardboard box wrapped with festive paper, a laundry basket, or any other similar type of container. Putnam CAP asks that the food box contain all of the items needed to make a traditional Thanksgiving Dinner as well as some additional items such as breakfast foods and food for another meal during the week.

All food baskets should include a \$25 grocery store gift card for the purchase of a turkey as our freezer space is extremely limited.

Dinner Rolls (fresh or frozen),
Aluminum Roasting Pan,
